Don't Miss the Smaller Show by Weeks

In the back gallery is a curious exhibit of small, egg tempera on wood paintings by Marshall, Minn., artist Michon Weeks. Each is defined by a surface of dense repetitive markings from which emerges the image, or partial image of a car whose wheels take the form of a cross.

Religious paintings of a sort, the title of each obsessive work, such as "Just as I Am" or "Thief in the Night" is taken from the Bible.

Seemingly dense, although born of a simple visual theme, Week's minimal works symbolize spiritual travel and are worth investigating.
